**Luke 5:1-11**

**INTRODUCTION**

When you read the Gospels, two things are clear. Being a sinner doesn't disqualify you from following Jesus. And being an unbeliever doesn't disqualify you from following Jesus. So, what does that mean for you?

**DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

1. Reread Luke 5:1-11. What do you notice about the story this time? What stands out to you? What new thing did you hear? What did you hear more clearly this time because of something Claire shared in her message?
2. What disqualifies you from being called by Jesus? What excuses do you use to not participate in God's work in the world?
3. What do you think being called by Jesus means for you?
4. How is Jesus getting personal in your life?
5. How is Jesus gaining your trust?
6. Many people don't have a big huge moment of calling from God. What if you are like the Peter's fishing partners? They don't have the direct interaction with Jesus, but they receive the same call as Peter. What has your call story been like? Are you more like Peter or his fishing partners?

**KEEPING IN STEP**

Claire said "Your calling is about how you go about living your life. Are you fishing people? Are you building relationships that are personal that are filled with trust? Are you sharing your story of God in your life through your actions, your attitudes, your priorities?" Discuss what sharing your story of God through actions, attitudes and priorities could look like in your life.
