Discussion Questions
Jeremiah: 29:11-13

INTRODUCTION

God is not always easy to find in the circumstances of life, but that doesn't mean God is not there. How do we find God during the difficult times? IN this series we hear from people who found God in the midst of their "Where's God?" moments.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Share with your group plans you have for this summer. What do you hope your plans will accomplish?
2. Read Scripture. Talk about how this passage encourages you. How it causes you to wonder? How do you reconcile the plans you have for your future with plans God may have for you?
3. Recall a time when you recognized that God's plans were different than from your own?
4. Pr. Jon shared that all through the biblical narrative God's people experienced 'where's God' moments and seasons. Can you name a moment or season that you have wondered the same?
5. Give some reasons why God's ways and plans may be more mysterious in some seasons of our life?
6. How can we cultivate confidence in God's plans for our lives and the lives of our loved ones?
7. What one thing can the group pray for you today?

STAY IN STEP

In Jeremiah 29 God declares that when we search for God and seek Him, we will find Him. Seeking God is a matter of will not skill. It is not how well you believe or how

much bible you know, it's a question of desire, a sincere heart. God promises to reveal himself when we simply ask, each day, "God what is your will for me today?" And in those 'Where's God' moments our request can be, "God I want to see you in this moment, in this season." Keep praying!
